

Offices to be filled in the South Dakota 2010 Elections

The following nominations are made in the party primary elections held on June 8, 2010:

- U.S. Representative – 2 year term
- U.S. Senator – 6 year term
- Governor – 4 year term
- 105 Legislators (35 Senate, 70 House) – 2 year term
- County Commissioners – 4 year term
- County Auditor – 4 year term
- County Register of Deeds – 4 year term
- County Sheriff – 4 year term
- Delegates to Republican Party State Convention (three per county). Other state convention delegates are county chairman, vice chairman, state committee members, and each precinct committeeman and committeewoman.
- Delegates to the Democratic Party State Convention – Each County shall send a minimum of four delegates, one being the County Chair or the next higher officer and three shall be elected. In addition, the County shall elect one delegate for every 1,500 votes (or major fraction thereof) over 4,000 cast in that County in the last General Election for the Democratic candidate for Governor. Voting delegates to the State Convention, who will be seated with their County delegations, shall also automatically include the following classifications of Party Officers: Precinct Committeeman, Precinct Committeewoman, County Vice Chair, County Secretary, County Treasurer and Legislative District Chair. The Legislative District Chair shall be seated with the County delegation where the Officer is registered to vote.

In those areas of the state which have the following types of districts, nominations are made in a nonpartisan primary election:

- Water Development District Directors -- all directors will be up for election in 2010 due to changes in the district boundaries. All odd number area directors will run for a 4 year term and all even number area directors will run for a 2 year term.
- Heartland Consumers Power District Directors -- 6 year term

The following will be nominated at the 2010 state conventions of each political party:

- Lieutenant Governor – 4 year term
- Secretary of State – 4 year term
- Attorney General – 4 year term
- State Auditor – 4 year term
- State Treasurer – 4 year term
- Commission of School and Public Lands – 4 year term
- Public Utilities Commissioner – 6 year term
