**Edward P. Riley, Ph.D.**

San Diego State University, San Diego, CA

Dr. Riley is a Distinguished Professor of Psychology and Director of the Center for Behavioral Teratology at San Diego State University. He has authored over 250 scientific papers and reviews and served as Chair of the U.S. National Task Force on FAS/FAE from 2000-2004 at the request of the US Secretary of Health. He currently serves on the Expert Panel for the SAMHSA FASD Center for Excellence and previously served as Chair of this committee. He is a Past-President of the Research Society on Alcohol (RSA), The Fetal Alcohol Study Group of the RSA, and the Behavioral Teratology Society. He is the President-Elect of the International Society for Biomedical Research on Alcoholism. He is currently a member of the National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism Council and until recently was a member of the Behavioral and Social Advisory Council of the ABMRF/The Foundation for Alcohol Research. He has received numerous awards for his scholarship and contributions to the alcohol field, including the RSA Distinguished Researcher Award, the National Organization on Fetal Alcohol Syndrome Research Recognition Award, and most recently the Frank Seixas Award from the RSA.
